Statement	<p>Public transit may be used in Guelph to serve eligible grade 7 to grade 12 students where it makes economic sense to do so.</p> <p>Public transit may also be used for students requiring life skills development.</p>
Procedures	<p>Transit Tickets:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students receive public transit tickets to cover their travel to and from school on scheduled school days. Students that receive transit tickets are given 10 tickets per week. Students receiving these tickets must sign the ticket log to indicate that they have received the tickets and that they will use them exclusively for travel to and from school.2. Students in grade 7 and 8 who reside in Guelph, do not qualify for transportation, and who live between 4.0 km and 4.8 km of their home school will receive 40 transit tickets per year to be used between December and March on inclement weather days.3. Once a student has received his/her tickets, he/she is responsible for them. No damaged, lost or stolen tickets will be replaced by STWDSTS or by the school. The student and his/her parents are responsible for covering the costs of the student's school transportation.4. In the event that a student uses his/her tickets for purposes other than school transportation, he/she must make arrangements for travelling to and from school, and must cover the expenses.5. The ticket log is kept at school, but may be consulted upon request by employees of STWDSTS, for verification purposes. <p>Transit Passes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students receive public transit passes to cover their travel to and from school on scheduled school days.2. STWDSTS administers transit passes for students on behalf of Guelph Transit.3. Passes are issued twice a year according to secondary school semesters.

Procedures...continued	<ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Students that receive a transit pass must sign and record the number on the pass issued to them on the bus pass log to indicate that they have received the transit pass.5. Once a student has received his/her transit pass, he/she is responsible for the pass. No damaged, lost or stolen pass will be replaced by STWDSTS or by the school. The student and his/her parents are responsible for covering the costs of the student's school transportation.6. A copy of the transit pass log will be sent to the STWDSTS office by the end of September.
