Statement	STWDSTS recognizes that parents and guardians may require childcare for their children. While STWDSTS accepts only one primary address for each student whom it serves, transportation from a caregiver may be provided using (017) Courtesy Transportation and applying the criteria herewithin.
Procedures	<p>The provision of transportation to and from a caregiver is dependent upon the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The parent/guardian submits a written request to the principal on an annual basis. 2. The student is eligible for transportation under (002) Transportation Eligibility. 3. The addition of the student to the alternate bus does not cause that student load to exceed the rated capacity of the vehicle. 4. The alternate transportation follows a regular schedule 5 days per week. 5. Only stops approved by STWDSTS are used. 6. The student normally rides on the same bus in both directions. 7. The alternate transportation does not require transferring from one bus to another. 8. The caregiver’s address is within the attendance boundary of the student’s home school in accordance with (012) Out-of-Boundary Students. 9. Parents/guardians sign the Alternate Transportation Permission Request form (TF005) indicating they understand that this accommodation is temporary, is subject to the conditions listed in this policy detail and may be withdrawn immediately upon notice that: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Student behaviour is unacceptable; b) Changes in the population of the area result in transportation needs which exceed the maximum allowable number of students on a bus; and, c) Copies of the approved Alternative Transportation Permission Request form (TF005) have not been received by the parents or guardians, school and STWDSTS.
